Purchase Order Terms and Conditions

These Terms and Conditions together with a purchase order form the agreement ("Agreement"). Purchase orders shall be in writing and duly signed by BC Motorhomes in order to be valid and enforceable. Any document of Supplier which purports to modify the Agreement does not apply unless expressly accepted in writing by BC Motorhomes.

If there is any conflict between the terms of this Agreement and any other written and signed agreement between the parties relating to the relevant Goods or Services, then the terms of the other agreement shall apply in precedence to this Agreement.

1. Interpretation

1.1 All references to the following expressions in the Agreement shall, unless the context otherwise requires, have the following meanings:

1.1.1 Affiliate of BC Motorhomes means any legal entity, directly or indirectly owned and/or controlled by BC Motorhomes Plc.

1.1.2 Confidential Information means any and all tangible and intangible information disclosed hereunder, including but not limited to: software, data, specifications, standards and know-how of any nature such as technical, scientific, engineering, commercial, financial, marketing or organizational, which (i) is marked as "confidential, "proprietary" or with some similar indication; (ii) is expressly advised by the disclosing party to be confidential through some contemporaneous oral or written means; or (iii) which the receiving party would reasonably construe to be of a confidential nature considering the circumstances of its disclosure and/or the nature of the information. The definition of Confidential Information shall, however, not include informationwhich (i) at the time of disclosure ispart of the public domain, or which thereafter comes into the public domain through no fault of the receiving party, (ii) at the time of disclosure was already in the legitimate possession of the receiving party without any confidentiality restrictions, as evidenced by written records (iii) was developed by employees or agents of the receiving party independently of and without reference to any Confidential Information communicated to the receiving party; and (iv) which is properly received by the receiving party from a third party which has the right to disclose such information.

1.1.3 Effective Date has the meaning given to it in the purchase order.

1.1.4 "Goods or Services" means any goods or services supplied or provided by the Supplier;

1.1.5 BC Motorhomes Group means BC Motorhomes and its Affiliates.

1.1.6 Intellectual Property Rights means patents, trademarks, service marks, trade or business names, domain names, registered designs, layout design rights, registered designs, semiconductor topography rights, database rights, copyrights, rights in computer software, rights protecting trade secrets and confidential information, rights protecting goodwill and reputation and other similar or corresponding proprietary rights and all applications for the same, whether presently existing or created in the future, anywhere in the world, whether registered or unregistered, and all rights to sue, recover damages and obtain relief or other remedies for any past,

current or future infringement, misappropriate or violation of any of the foregoing rights.

1.1.7 Service Levels mean the service levels detailed in purchase order or otherwise agreed in writing between the parties.

1.1.8 Works means any and all inventions, processes, methods, prototypes, works of authorship, drawings, logos, developments, concepts, improvements, documents, articles, reports and/or any other materials whether or not patentable, copyrightable or subject

to other forms of protection.

2. Term

2.1 This Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and continue for the period stated in the purchase order. If no period is stated, the Agreement shall continue until the Goods or Services have been properly delivered in accordance with this Agreement. Thereafter the Agreement will automatically expire. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Clauses 8 to 16 (inclusive) shall survive termination or expiration of this Agreement.

3. Goods and Services

3.1 The Supplier will supply the Goods and Services: (a) using all reasonable skill and care; and (b) in compliance with: (i) the requirements of this Agreement; (ii) all policies that BC Motorhomes provides to Supplier in writing from time to time; (ii) in accordancewithany Service Levels; and (iii) all applicablelaws.

3.2 The Supplier shall comply with all reasonable directions from time to time given to it by BC Motorhomes and shall comply and ensure the compliance of its employees and representatives with any policies and guidelines provided or informed by BC Motorhomes. The Supplier agrees to work and co-operate with any servant or agent or other consultant of BC Motorhomes and adhere strictly toany rules or guidelines given by BC Motorhomes in respect of the provision of the Goods and Services.

3.3 The Supplier shall not delegate, subcontract or otherwise arrange for a third party to perform any part of this Agreement without the prior written consent of BC Motorhomes. The Supplier is at all times liable to BC Motorhomes for the acts, defaults and neglects of any subcontractor, or any employee or agent of a subcontractor, as if they were the acts, defaults or neglects of the Supplier.

3.4 The Supplier shall keep BC Motorhomes informed of its provision of the Goods and Services as requested from time to time by BC Motorhomes and make available any necessary related documentation (as determined conclusively by BC Motorhomes) for inspection.

3.5 The Supplier represents and warrants to BC Motorhomes, on an ongoing basis, that the Goods and Services will not include or give access to any material which is: (a) in any way harmful to BC Motorhomes or its systems; (b) contains any open source (or similar) software; (c) is offensive, blasphemous, obscene, defamatory or illegal; and/or (d) breaches any applicable laws.

4. Packaging and Delivery

4.1 The Supplier shall, at its expense mark Goods with the purchase order number, crate, package or otherwiseprepare goods for shipment in accordance with BC Motorhomes's instructions and otherwise will ensure safe and secure delivery to BC Motorhomes. The Supplier will include a packing slip with the shipment of Goods.

4.2 Goods are to be shipped to the delivery point set out in the purchase order by the due date set out in the purchase order.

4.3 If the Supplier does not comply with the delivery schedule, BC Motorhomes may cancel the purchase order without liability.

5. Inspection and Acceptance

5.1 Goods shall be deemed not to have been accepted until BC Motorhomes has inspected the Goods, conducted acceptance tests and signified its acceptance.

5.2 If BC Motorhomes determines that supplied Goods in whole or part do not conform to the Agreement it may, without prejudice to any other remedies available to it (i) return (at the Supplier's expense)

the whole or any part of the Goods for repair, replacement or credit; (ii) repair the Goods at the Supplier's expense; or (c) require the Supplier to fix any defects.

5.3 If BC Motorhomes determines that supplied Services do not conform to the Agreement in whole or in part, it may, without prejudice to any other remedies available to it: (i) require the Supplier to supply the Services again at the Supplier's cost; or (ii) arrange tohave the Servicessupplied by a different supplierat the Supplier's cost; or (iii) require the Supplier to provide it with a credit equal to the price of the Services.

5.4 Where the Supplier is supplying Goods to specifications, BC Motorhomes reserves the right to inspect these items and Supplier's facilities at reasonable times during any stage of manufacture.

6. Title and Risk

6.1 Risk of loss for Goods shall pass to BC Motorhomes at the delivery point specified in the purchase order. Title to the Goods shall pass to BC Motorhomes on dispatch of the Goods from the Supplier.

7. Fees, Invoicing and Payment

7.1 No extra charges of any kind (including but not limited to packing, boxing, crating, delivery freight or insurance) will be paid by BC Motorhomes unless provided for in the purchase order.

7.2 Prices shown on a purchase order are not subject to escalation or variation for any reason whatsoever unless agreed to in writing by BC Motorhomes.

7.3 Supplier represents and warrants that the prices quoted in a purchaseorder shall notbeinexcessof Supplier'slist, catalogue or published prices.

7.4 Invoices for Goods are to be submitted electronically via the Coupa platform and must show the purchase order number. Accounts will be settled 60 days from receipt of the Supplier's invoice.

7.5 In the case of Services, the Supplier shall invoice BC Motorhomes electronically via the Coupa platform for the Services provided on a monthly basis, unless otherwise specifically stated in the purchase order. The invoices shall contain a specification of the Services performed and, if applicable, a specification over the expenses for which BC Motorhomes is reimbursing the Supplier during the period in question. Payment shall be made by BC Motorhomes within 60 days from receipt of correct invoice.

7.6 BC Motorhomes will not pay for Services performed or Goods supplied by the Supplier in excess of the Agreement. Excess Goods will be returned at the Supplier's expense.

7.7 Except as otherwise specified in a purchase order, the price includes all local or foreign taxes (including any goods and service tax), stamp duties and other governmental charges.

7.8 BC Motorhomes is entitledtoset off anyamount owing at any time by Supplier.

7.9 All invoices are to be submitted only after completion and acceptance of the relevant Goods and Services.

8. Confidentiality

8.1 Without limitations in point of time, the Parties agree that with respect to any Confidential Information, the receiving party undertakes for itself and for any of its employees, directors, subcontractors and representatives:

(i) to use such Confidential Information only as necessary in order to fulfil the obligations and exercise the rights set out herein; (ii) not to disclose any Confidential Information to a third party for any purposes unless expressly authorized by the disclosing party or as required by law; and (iii) not to copy or reduce Confidential Information to writing or store in a machine readable form.

9. Intellectual Property Rights and Indemnity

9.1 The Supplier grants to BC Motorhomes an irrevocable, nonexclusive, transferable, royalty-free licence (with the right to sublicence), to use background intellectual property rights in connection with the Goods and Services and for the use, repair, maintenance, upgrade or modification of the Goods and Services.

9.2 The Supplier agrees and acknowledges that any and all rights title and interests (including Intellectual Property Rights) in and to all Works made, created, developed, written, reduced to practice, produced or conceived by the Supplier, in whole orinpart, eithersolelyorjointlywith others, as a resultoforin connection with the provision of the Goods and Services under this Agreement (" BC Motorhomes Property") upon receipt of full payment of the Fees to the Supplier shall vest and remain at all times in BC Motorhomes. The Supplier assigns to BC Motorhomes all rights title and/or interest in and to the BC Motorhomes Property to which the Supplieris or may be entitled to by virtue of or pursuant to any of the laws in force in any part of the world.

9.3 At the request of BC Motorhomes, the Supplier shall give and supply all suchinformation, data, drawings and assistance as may be necessary to enable BC Motorhomes to exploit the BC Motorhomes Property and shall execute all documents and do all such things, which may be necessary or desirable for obtaining, registering or otherwise protecting or recording or enforcing the BC Motorhomes Property in such parts of the world as may be specified by BC Motorhomes and for vesting the same in BC Motorhomes for the full term of such rights.

9.4 The Supplier acknowledges that, except as provided by law, no further fees other than that provided for in this Agreement, is or may become due to the Supplier in respect of its compliance with this Clause.

9.5 The Supplier shall indemnify and hold harmless BC Motorhomes, its Affiliatesandtheirrespectiveofficers, directors, employeesand agents (" BC Motorhomes Indemnitees") against any action brought or threatened against the BC Motorhomes Indemnitees based on a claim that the Goods or Services or any provision of the Goods or Services infringes any Intellectual Property Rights of any third party orconstitutesmisappropriationorunlawfuldisclosureor use of any third party's trade secrets or confidential

information; and/or a breach of Clause 8.

10. Personal Data Protection

10.1 In case either the Supplierwill process any personal data on behalf of BC Motorhomes, the Supplier shall at all times comply with the provisions and obligations imposed on it by any applicable legislation relating to the protection of personal data and with the guidelines and guidance notes issued from time to time by the relevant authorities.

10.2 The Supplier shall ensure that:

a) it shall at all times act only in accordance with the reasonable instructions and administrative requirements of BC Motorhomes in relation to the personal data;

b) personal data isonly used for the purposes authorised by the data controller, as defined by law;

c) personal data is kept only for aslong asit is necessary to fulfil obligations under this Agreement or as required by mandatory law after which it shall be deleted or destroyed;

d) all personal data is kept securely, segregated from the processing party's or any third party's data, in strict confidence and in accordance with the applicable law;

e) all necessary technical and organisational measures are in place to prevent unauthorised or unlawful processing or accidental loss, damage or destruction of personal data; and

f) all necessary steps are in place to ensure the reliability of its staff who will have access to such personal data.

g) it notifies BC Motorhomes immediately upon becoming aware of any unauthorised disclosure of personal data and/or a personal data breach and following notification shall provide such information and assistance to BC Motorhomes as is reasonably required by BC Motorhomes in the circumstances.

10.3 The Supplier shall defend, indemnify and hold BC Motorhomes harmless from and against any and all losses, damages, costs and expenses incurred as a result of the breach of this Clause.

11. Anti-Bribery

11.1 The Supplier agrees to comply with all applicable anti- bribery and corruption laws in connection with this Agreement. The Supplier further undertakes that it shall not in connection with its performance under this Agreement or any other transactions involving this Agreement, make, promise, offer or receive any money, anything of value or an advantage (including bribes and kickbacks), directly or indirectly, to or from: (i) any government official; (ii) any political party; or (iii) any person or entity to obtain or retain business or an improper advantage for itself and/or for the other party.

12. Modern Slavery

12.1 The Supplier shall at all times comply with: all applicable laws, regulations and sanctions relating to modern slavery and human trafficking including but not limited to the Modern Slavery Act 2015; and any anti-slavery policy adopted by BC Motorhomes from time to time.

12.2 The Supplier shall implement and maintain throughout the duration of this Agreement due diligence procedures for its own suppliers, permitted sub-contractors and other participants in its supply chains, to ensure that there is no slavery or human trafficking in its supply chains.

12.3 The Supplier shall notify BC Motorhomes as soon as it becomes aware of any breach, or potential breach, of any anti-slavery policy adopted by BC Motorhomes from time to time; or any actual or suspected slavery or human trafficking in a supply chain which has a connection with this Agreement.

13. Limitation of Liability

13.1 Nothing will limit either party's liability for: (a) any indemnity provided to the other party under this Agreement;

(b) wilful misconduct or deliberate default; (c) death or personalinjury causedbythatparty'snegligence;(e)fraud; or

(f) any other liability that cannot be excluded by law.

13.2 Subject to Clause 13.1; (a) neither party will be liable for any indirectorconsequentialloss; (b)Supplier'stotalliabilityin connection with this Agreement will be limited to an amount equal to the greater of(i) £100,000 and (ii) 250% of the total amounts paid and payable whether invoiced or not to the Supplier under this Agreement;

and (c) BC Motorhomes's total liability in connection with this Agreement shall be limited to an amount equal to the total of the amounts paid and payable whether invoiced or not to the Supplier under this Agreement.

13.3 The Supplier shall, if requested by BC Motorhomes, at its sole expense, effectproperinsurances againstall risks arising under this agreement (including public liability, product liability and employee insurance) and shall, if required by BC Motorhomes, produce evidence of the currency and validity of any such policy.

14. Termination

14.1 Notwithstanding anything in this Agreement, this Agreement may beterminated:

a) by either party on giving notice inwriting to the other partyif that party commits any material breach of any term of this Agreement, and in the case of a breach capable of being remedied, shall have failed within thirty (30) days after the receipt of a request in writing to do so; or b) by either party should the other party during the term of this Agreement stop its payments, enterinto administration, liquidation or other type of insolvency.

14.2 On termination orexpiry of this Agreement for any reason whatsoever, the Supplier shall immediately return to BC Motorhomes all copies of any information and data supplied by BC Motorhomes for the purposes of this Agreement (including materials containing Confidential Information of BC Motorhomes) and shall certify to BC Motorhomes that no copies thereof have been retained.

14.3 Any expiry or termination of this Agreementhowsoever occasioned shall not affect any rights orliabilities of any party nor shall it affect the coming into force of or continuation of any provision hereof which is expressly or by implication intended to come into force on or after such expiration or termination.

15. Notices

15.1 All notices to or by the Parties shall be inwriting in the English language and shall be delivered by hand, courier or ordinary mail to the other party.

16. Miscellaneous

16.1 The Supplier shall not assign or transfer any right or obligation under this Agreement without BC Motorhomes's prior written consent.

16.2 The Supplier agrees not enter into any agreement or arrangement which will be binding on BC Motorhomes or any entity within the BC Motorhomes Group without the prior written consent of BC Motorhomes.

16.3 No term or provision shall be deemed waived and no breach excused, unless such waiver or consent shall be in writing and signed by the party against whom the waiver or consent isasserted.

16.4 In the event that any provision of this Agreement shall be determined invalid, unlawful or unenforceable to anyextent, such term, condition or provision shall be severed from the remaining terms, conditions and provisions of this Agreement, which shall continue to be valid to the fullest extent permitted by law.

16.5 Governing Law and Jurisdiction: This Agreement shall be subject to, governed and construed in accordance with the laws set out in England and the Parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
